Follow up to a complaint of vehicles being registered to another state: Letter was written to MMA with facts as known, and request for action needed by Selectmen to address and assure compliance with Maine law. MMA follow up letter cited relevant Maine Revised Statutes, and a recommendation to ask for information to support the claim of residency in another state. The vehicle owner provided proof of residency in New Hampshire, that he held title to the vehicle(s) in question, and the Town Clerk indicated there had been no attempt to declare residency in Maine nor had he attempted to apply for Homestead Exemption. For these reasons the Board feel no further action is required.

Property foreclosure discussed with decision deferred to the next meeting.

Inventory of Town property will be updated.

Road Commissioner to pick up barricades at White Sign. "Bump" signs will be priced also. Plan for road priorities for repair & reconstruction will be developed. River Rd boundary issue with D.F. discussed with former Selectman Kristy McLeod indicating it also needed repair. Discussion tabled. Will research and follow up with new D-F town manager if necessary.
